Explanation of Foot Notes

- (a) Add one (1) point for each Guardsman participating
 - (b) A minimum of three (3) Guardsmen is required to constitute a Color Guard
 - (c) A minimum of two (2) Guardsmen with muskets and one (1) as commander will be required to constitute a Firing Squad
 - (d) One Guardsman in uniform is sufficient for the presentation of awards at ROTC/JROTC or Eagle Scout recognitions
 - (e) CAR members and SAR Youth Registrants, DAR and SAR Ladies Auxiliary members (ladies dressed in Colonial attire) who perform as Guardsmen, Drummers, Fifers or banner carriers (identifying the color guard they are accompanying as an SAR unit) may be counted as SAR Guardsmen.
 - (f) Add ten (10) points for musket firing events.
 - (g) For award ceremonies held at schools, BSA Courts of Honor, ROTC/JROTC programs, etc.
- * No points are to be tallied for individual hits a website or the continuous posting of the item or interview.
