Advisor to the CASSAR President	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Identify CAR / SAR candidates for recognition.</i> 2. Advise the SAR State President in recognizing CAR members who have shown exemplary service to their society. They may be awarded the CAR Medal of Appreciation. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The bronze medal should be presented at the Chapter level during a regularly scheduled chapter event. • The silver medal should be presented at the Annual CAR State Meeting. • The gold medal may only be presented by the National Society. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Senior CAR officers from the DAR are also eligible to receive this medal and should be presented at the Annual State DAR Conference. ○ Members of the SAR are also eligible to receive this award for their contributions in supporting the CAR. He can serve as a senior officer, assist with field trips, civic projects and the many programs promoted for the CAR. 3. Report CASSAR activities of this Committee to the National CAR Liaison Committee <i>after the Annual Spring Membership Meeting.</i>

Maintain close communication with the Senior President of the CAR, coordinating the SAR Scholarship award and Certificate of Appreciation. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This cash award and certificate is presented at the annual meeting of the CAR and is awarded to the selected recipient for outstanding scholastic achievement. • The recipient should also be active in many ways that demonstrate ability, integrity and leadership potential. • Applications for this award should be received by the State Chairman by January 1st from the Senior CAR President.
