Attention compatriots – US Naval Sea Cadet Corps unit commanding officers are directed to follow the Sea Cadet Awards Manual when nominating your cadets for SAR awards. Per Awards Manual, Chapter 4, Section IV:

Sons of the American Revolution (SAR) bronze Good Citizenship Medal and Sea Cadet Medal Ribbon Bar – Awarded to an NSCC/NLCC cadet who has:

Attained the rate of Petty Officer Second Class or above (NSCC or NLCC) and is in good standing militarily and scholastically at the time of selection and presentation.

The cadet nominated must demonstrate a high degree of merit with respect to leadership qualities, military bearing, and excellence in the performance of duties; have the potential for greater leadership responsibilities; and be recommended by the unit Commanding Officer.

The recipient of the award will be selected and nominated to the local SAR Chapter ROTC/JROTC and Sea Cadet Chairman, or in his absence the Chapter President, who will normally make the award.

The award consists of an SAR bronze Good Citizenship Medal and accompanying SAR Sea Cadet ribbon bar (NSCC only) and an SAR certificate of recognition (NSCC/NLCC).
