



This aerial view of the Mission Inn shows the entire complex which, by itself is worth a visit. It rivals many European historic sites. From its modest beginnings as a 12-room adobe boarding house to its current stature consisting of 239 guest rooms, the *Mission Inn Hotel* has been a major tourist attraction in Southern California since 1876. In the late 1800's wealthy easterners and Europeans flocked to Riverside in search of a warmer winter climate along with the desire to invest



in the area's profitable citrus industry. In 1903 the 'Mission' wing was built in Mission-Revival style architecture and sought to incorporate different structural elements of the 21 California Missions. Over the years the hotel has played host to numerous celebrities and dignitaries. Ten U.S. Presidents stayed at the Mission Inn.
