#2 If establishing a new lineage or patriot as a junior member and the ancestor has not been documented or approved through NSSAR or DAR or C.A.R. in the past fees apply.

#3 Applications of the family members must be submitted at the same time and follow the same patriot lineage.

#4 The applicant must provide a copy of his birth certificate and proof of good standing along with a copy of his C.A.R. Record Copy.

#5 Memorial Members must pay the same dues and fees as a regular new member.
